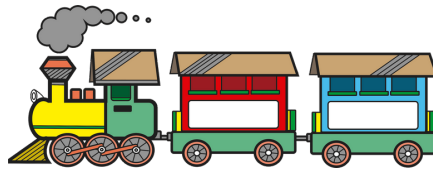

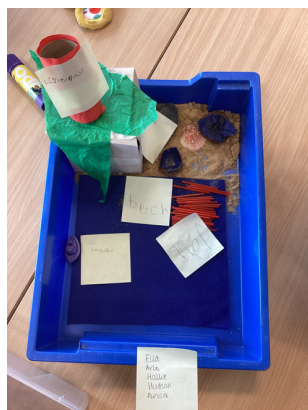
WHISTLESTOP VALLEY

YEAR 1 GEOGRAPHY

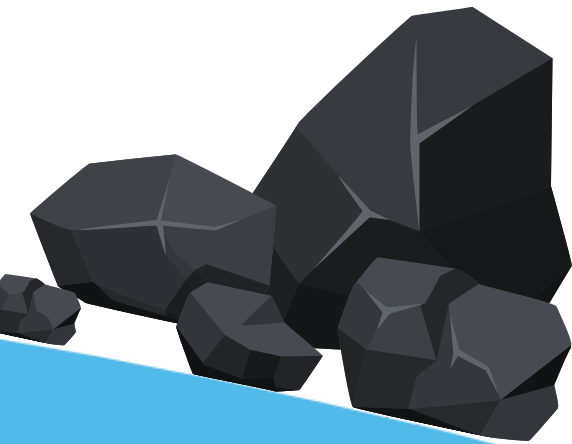
