COVID 19 Reporting Over February Half Term

11th February 2021

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we approach the end of a very different half term, may I say a huge thank you to all families and children for their dedication, support and enthusiasm.

We will not be providing any childcare provision over half term. School will be closed to all pupils. The children may not be in school, but this does not mean that they, their parents or family members may not test positive for Covid-19 while we are not at school.

Information and Guidance for the reporting of positive cases during February Half Term

If a pupil tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) and their symptoms started **more than 48 hours since** being in school (from anytime on Monday 15th February onwards if their last day in school was Friday 12th February), parents/carers **do not need to notify school** and should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

If a pupil tests positive and develops symptoms within 48 hours of having been in school, please email reportingcv19@oysterpark.co.uk and send a screen shot of the information from the NHS and the date they started with symptoms. If your child is asymptomatic, then we work from the date of the test. Parents and carers should notify school in the normal way on the first day of term if their child will be absent due to illness or isolation. We ask that all parents and carers follow this guidance, to protect our staff and children.

If a child or adult in a bubble tests positive within 48 hours of having been in school.

If school are notified of a positive case, be that children or staff, you will receive a notification via My Child at School and through a text message. Please direct questions to reportingcv19@oysterpark.co.uk and we will get back to you as soon as possible.
