

This is how we stay safe when we use computers in KS2:

- I will always ask permission from an adult before using the internet;
- I will only use websites and search engines that my teacher has chosen;
- I will use the school computers for school work unless I have permission otherwise;
- I know that not everything or everyone online is honest or truthful and will check content on other sources such as other websites, books or with a trusted adult;
- I always credit the person or source that created any work, image or text I use;
- I will only talk with and open messages from people I know and I only click on links if I know they are safe;
- I always talk to an adult if I'm not sure about something or if something happens online that makes me feel worried or frightened;
- I only send messages which are polite and friendly;
- I keep my personal information safe and private online;
- I will keep my passwords safe and not share them with anyone;
- I will not access or change other people's files or information;
- I will only post pictures or videos on the Internet if they are appropriate and if I have permission;
- I will only change the settings on the computer if a teacher/technician has allowed me to;
- I know that people I meet online may not always be who they say they are. If someone online suggests meeting up, I will immediately talk to an adult;
- I know that my use of school computers and Internet access will be monitored;
- I know that if I do not follow the rules then I might not be allowed to use the computers and tablets in school
- If I see anything online that I shouldn't or that makes me feel worried or upset then I will minimise the page and tell an adult straight away
- If I am aware of anyone being unsafe with technology then I will report it to a teacher;
