Social Skill Assembly: Mental Health

This week our assembly focused on Mental Health and we thought carefully about how we sometimes feel, think and behave. We discussed feelings and how sometimes we can't always explain how we are feeling. For example, occasionally we might feel low, anxious or unhappy but we can't think why. We concluded that this is ok but sometimes when we feel like this for too long we can begin to feel like we don't want to do anything at all. Some of the strategies we thought about to help us to improve our mental health were, speaking to someone about how we are feeling, eating a healthy diet, exercising for 30 minutes each day, doing kind things for others and thinking good things about ourselves.
