At Oyster Park Primary Academy, all children have access to an online learning platform. Nursery and Reception use Tapestry and Years 1 to 6 use Seesaw.

For those children, who do not have access to the virtual learning platform, paper copies of learning will be provided.



Online Learning Platform What is Tapestry?

Tapestry is a secure online Learning Journal to record photos, observations and comments, in line with the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum, to build up a record of your child's experiences during their time with us. This system allows us to work with parents and carers to share information and record the children's play and learning in and outside of the classroom.

Tapestry Via Desktop or Laptop Device



What is an 'observation'?



What you can tell us in your observation.

You can add a photo with a couple of words telling us:

What did they do?

What did they use?

Did they choose or did you suggest?

How did they communicate with you?

(e.g facial expresssions, sounds, talk with words, talk in sentences – you can include what they said if you wish)

Did they show you something new?

(e.g forming their name or recognising numbers for the first time)
