Mathematics Challenges


- Practise counting, in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.
- Practise writing the days of the week in order.
- How many months are there in the year? Can you write them down in the correct order? Can you find out how many days there are in each month?
- Order the coins from smallest to largest value. How many different ways can you make 10p?
- Be the teacher and write addition and subtraction number sentences for you family. Make sure you calculate the answers to make sure they are correct.
- Learn to tell the time to the hour and half past on a digital clock.

Science Challenges



- Make a list of all the body parts that you can name. Can you write a sentence to describe what you can do with the different parts of your body?
- Research the skeleton. What amazing facts can you find out about it?
- Why do we have teeth? Create a poster about their job and how we can look after our teeth.
- Use your senses to write a poem about what you can see, hear, taste, touch and smell.

History Challenge




- Find out what happened on the day you were born. Write a report to tell people what happened.

General Knowledge Challenge




- Research the Pacific Ocean. What animals would you see there? Where do people live and what is special about their culture?
