Mathematics Challenges

- Write your daily routine. Can you write down what time you do each of the different activities?



ICT Challenges

- Can you write an algorithm (instructions) on how to wash your hands?

History Challenge

General Knowledge Challenge

- The 7th July is World Chocolate Day. Can you find out how chocolate is made?
- Create a list of rules of how you can keep safe in the sun and near water.
- In the last set of challenges, we asked you to find out about the different sports at the Olympic Games. Can you find out where the first Olympic Games took place?



Geography Challenge

- Design your own town. Can you think which physical and human features will need to be included?
