- Shine a torch through a variety of materials such as newspaper, card and a blanket to find out which materials are transparent, translucent or opaque. Which materials will let light through?




- Which materials/objects float or sink? Investigate and use your scientific knowledge to explain why.

- Design a healthy meal using all of the food groups.




Mathematics Challenges

- Go on a right-angle hunt around your home. Record the objects you identified.
- Play times tables bingo with the people at home.
- You have £10. Use a catalogue to work out what it would cost to buy certain items. How much change will you receive? Use the column method for addition and subtraction to calculate the answer.
- Play Simon Says with a maths twist. Using your arms etc. demonstrate parallel lines, an acute angle etc.



Geography Challenge

- Create your own treasure map using compass points.
- Use google maps to locate places of interests near your home.
- Create a fact file about Ferry Fryston or Castleford.
- Find out the names of some British rivers.
- Create a labelled picture or model of a river from source to mouth.



Creative Challenge

- Create your own piece of art in the style of McKenzie Thorpe.
