- Write an acrostic poem about being happy and what it means to you.


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## Mathematics Challenges

- Find out about the animals that live in the sea. What is the biggest threat to them? Think about pollution. Create an information poster to display your findings.




- What is the Summer Solstice? When is it this year?

  - Create a Jar of Happiness




## Geography Challenges
