- Watch the weather forecast on tv. Now create your own weather forecast for a place of your choice.
- Hide some treasure, create a map compass points and co-ordinates.

## Creative Challenge

- Research the art work of Antoni Gaudí. Create a fact file about him and his work.
- Sketch the Sagrada Familia



- Create a 3d model of the Sagrada Familia: using materials such as cardboard, playdough etc.
- Sketch and colour 'the dragon' in Park Güell- Antonio Gaudí.
